According to non-profit group San Francisco Soccer, SF has fewer soccer fields per player than almost any city in the US. The unveiling of the new 'Hidden' Soccer field on Pier 27 should ease that statistic a bit. Featuring lighting and a synthetic grass playing surface, the field has sat empty for the past two years. Now, after being leased from the Port of San Francisco by SF Soccer, the field is available for rentals and games. Currently the field has free lunchtime pick-up games, and this Sept, SF Soccer plans to have a full schedule of programs.
